That the proposed point of diversion, the approximate location and size of the diverting channel, all reservoirs or basins, the location and names of all other works which will cross or connect with the proposed works and the boundary of all lands, showing by 40-acre subdivisions the areas proposed to be irrigated, are fully and correctly designated thereon.


