

Hunter, being first duly sworn depose and say that this map consisting of 3 sheets has been correctly drawn to the designated scale from field notes of a survey made under my supervision and direction between the 9th day of March and the 17th day of April 1974, and from aerial photographs taken on the 20th day of March 1974; that it truly represents the proposed location and the extent of the works used to divert water from Winnemucca Valley Creek and tributaries and underground sources in Washoe County, by Inter-Mountain Land Co. for irrigation and domestic purposes. That the proposed points of diversion, the approximate location and size of the diverting channel, all reservoirs or basins, the name and location of all other works which will cross or connect with proposed works, and the boundaries of all land, showing by 40-acre subdivisions the area proposed to be irrigated, are fully and correctly designated thereon.
