BASIS OF BEARING: TRUE NORTH USING A MAGNETIC DECLINATION OF 17°30' EAST




ILLUSTRATION OF THE EXISTING PLACE OF USE UNDER PERMIT NUMBER 43925 / SCALE: 1"=1 MILE
