The section line between section 36 of T12S, R68E and section 31 of T12S, R69E found BLM brass cap survey marker at the common point of section 25 and section 36 of T12S, R68E, and section 30 and section 31 of T12S, R69E also at the common point of section 36 of T12S, R68E and section 31 of T12S, R69E is a Lincoln County and Clark County boundary. The line between the two aforementioned point has a bearing of S 4° 02' W

In the northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of the southwest (SW 1/4) of sec 21 township 12 south, range 68 east M.D. & M. bears S 56° 26' E a distance of 23,231.97 ft.
