


EXISTING POINT OF DIVERSION



NOTE:

The existing place of use is under the present right-of-way of I-80, as shown on Map No. 29413. The proposed place of use is on the Barrechea property, designated as the Gassiot property on Map No. 29413. Gassiot's original right was 36.0 acre feet annually, 4.0 acre feet of this right was later sold to Alice M. Trail, leaving a total of 32.0 acre feet to be transferred to the Barrechea property. At a rate of 4.50 acre feet per acre a total of 7.11 acres could be irrigated by this right by Barrechea on the portion of his property shown as the proposed place of use. The exact location of this 7.11 acres would be shown on the cultural map supporting the Proof of Beneficial Use. A corresponding area of 7.11 acres should be stripped from the existing place of use as shown by the cross hatched area.

Lindesmith, being first duly sworn, depose and say that this map, consisting of one sheet, has been correctly drawn to the designated scale from information compiled from the maps supporting Permit Nos. 29413 and 14056 on file with the State Engineer, Record of Survey Map No. 746, File No. 266076, filed in the Official Records of Washoe County, Nevada on November 20, 1972, and deeds Book 1758, Page 0238, File No. 801531 and Book 1758, Page 0241, File No. 801532, filed in the Official Records of Washoe County, Nevada on June 21, 1982; that it truly and correctly represents the location and extent of the works used to divert water from the Truckee River, in Washoe County by Luis Barrechea for irrigation purposes under a portion of Permit No. 29413 (Claim No. 634 of the Truckee River Decree); the point of diversion, and the location of the proposed place of use, the names and location of all the works which will cross or connect with the proposed works, and the boundary of all lands showing by 40 acre subdivision, and the areas proposed for irrigation use are shown hereon.
