


EXISTING PLACE OF USE, A PORTION OF SEC. 2, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.M.



T.19N., R.19E., M.D.M.**




BASIS OF BEARINGS

A PORTION OF SEC. 1, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.M.**



