




I, Robert J. Gibson, being first duly sworn, depose and say that this map, consisting of 1 sheet, has been correctly drawn to the designated scale from field notes of a survey made by me, or under my supervision and direction, on the 29th day of December, 2015; that it truly and correctly represents the proposed location and extent of the works used to divert water from Porter Springs for the purpose of wildlife watering and habitat, and from Unnamed Spring 78-40 for the purpose of human and domestic livestock consumption as defined in the executive order of 1926 known as "Public Water Reserves No. 107", in Humboldt County, by the USDI Bureau of Land Management; that the point of diversion, the location and size of the diverting channel or other conduit, the place and manner of use, and the location and names of all other works or streams which are crossed by or connected with the said works, are fully and correctly designated thereon.

Basis of bearing is US Cadastral Survey digital Public Land Survey System data. Geographic coordinate values (NAD 83) were obtained by direct GPS measurements using a Garmin GPSmap 62st, with an accuracy of ± 3 meters.
