At the smaller spring is about 15' of 1 1/2" pipe conveying water to wooden trough 6' long, 3" wide and 2 1/2" deep. At the main spring, channel from said spring to small pool 5' in diameter has been cleaned, and from said pool water is conveyed thru about 15' of 1 1/2" pipe to a wooden trough 6' long, 3" wide and 15" deep and a semi-circular galvanized iron trough 10' long, 20" wide and 9" deep.  
 NOTE:- It is proposed to replace the two present troughs at the main spring with two or three larger wood troughs, each to be about 14' long, 26 inches wide and 11" deep. Present troughs have been installed and in use a great many years by applicant and his predecessors.
