1. National Forest: Toiyabe National Forest
2. Stream: Triple Springs
3. Authority: Organic Administration Act of 1897
4. Priority Date: April 15, 1907
5. Point of Diversion:
 - a. General: Within Meadow Canyon Administrative Site.
 - b. Legal: SE1/4 NE1/4, Section 20, T.10N., R.45E., MDM (unsurveyed), or at a point from which the SE corner Section 31, T.10N., R.45E., bears S20°00'W at a distance of 15,050 feet.
6. Place of Use: Within Meadow Canyon Administrative Site.
7. Purpose: Meadow Canyon Administrative Site is used for administering programs of watershed protection.
8. Type of Use: The water from Triple Springs is used for the following purposes:

Stock watering (450 horse days/mo)	May 1 through Oct. 31
Irrigation (20 acres pasture)	May 1 through Sept 30
