



 - b. Legal: NW1/4 SW1/4, Section 21, T.10N., R.45E., MDM (unsurveyed), or at a point from which the SE corner Section 31, T.10N., R.45E., bears S27°00'W at a distance of 14,000 feet.
- 6. Place of Use: Within Meadow Canyon Administrative Site.


