



13) Remarks:

The amount of water claimed is that volume which will support healthy, vigorous riparian vegetation necessary to maintain the claimed surface flow for the identified purposes. 0.0028 cfs is needed for described use. This is also an important source of water for human use including current and future uses such as hiking, horseback riding and camping. Use at this spring also serves wildlife species; making it an important source of water for wildlife. Water quality is appropriate for purposes and types of uses claimed. The riparian area will serve to provide clean water for both human and animal consumption, wildlife habitat, and forage for wild and domesticated animals. The source is undeveloped. The spring location and place of use are on lands owned by the United States.




