This amended notification is being submitted to correct the UTM coordinates provided in the amended claim from March, 2014. Approximately 13.98 GPM are needed for cattle and wild horse use in this allotment. Within this allotment, we estimate that there are 2,386 deer, 494 antelope, and 476 bighorn sheep, some of which have the potential to use this spring. Their water needs are 20 GPD (0.026 CFS), a portion of which could be taken at this spring source and would not be available for appropriation. We therefore request the full amount of available water at the source.

The source and place of use both exist on lands owned by the United States which is managed by the BLM.






