
Tonopah Resource Area Wildlife Biologist has determined that 10 mule deer,  
5 bighorn sheep and at least one mountain lion use Nick Spring as a water  
source. The consumptive water use supporting that population is estimated to  
be .000225 cfs or 150 gpd. This spring source is also used by various other  
wildlife species. Minimum water needs at the spring source is therefore  
estimated to be .002175 cfs (.00195 cfs + .000225 cfs) or 1450 gallons per  
day.
