(11) Remarks The BLM, Battle Mountain District, Tonopah Resource Area, Wildlife Biologist, has determined that Blue Dick Spring #1 is used by 10 mule deer. The consumptive water use supporting that population is estimated to be .00007 cfs or 40 gpd. This spring source is also used by a variety of nongame species including coyote, rabbits, antelope squirrel and songbirds, as well as population of chukars. Water is

needed at the spring source for their consumptive and habitat requirement needs. Minimum water need at the spring source is therefore estimated to be .00192 cfs or 1240 gpd.


