1. National Forest: Humboldt National Forest
2. Stream: Gordon Creek
3. Authority: Multiple-Use Sustained-Yield Act of 1960
4. Priority Date: June 12, 1960
5. Purpose: Fish and Wildlife Habitat
6. Location of Quantification Point:
 - a. General: East side of the East Humboldt Mountains
 - b. Legal: NE1/4SE1/4, sec. 23, T. 34 N., R. 61 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian (unsurveyed), or at a point from which the NE section corner of sec. 23, T. 34 N., R. 61 E. bears north at a distance of 2800 feet.
7. Instream Flow Claim: a continuous instream flow defined and distributed as follows:

<u>Duration</u>	<u>Streamflow (cfs)</u>
April 1 thru September 30	1.8
October 1 thru March 31	1.2


8. In the event that natural flows do not attain the rates decreed above, the United States shall be entitled to the natural flows actually occurring during the time periods described above.
9. Instream flows are necessary at all points along the stream within the boundary of the Humboldt National Forest and the quantification herein may be extrapolated to other stream reaches in this or nearby similar watersheds based on watershed area, precipitation, watershed characteristics, or combinations thereof.
