This reserved right and other water rights for livestock (wild horses and burros) grazing common to the same Herd Management Area (HMA) will be limited to the quantity of water beneficially used within the HMA. This spring location was determined in the field with the Global Positioning System (GPS). Accuracy is ±3 feet
