

(11) Remarks It is recognized that wildlife currently utilize this spring and therefore sufficient water should be left at the source for this purpose and not be available for appropriation. Wildlife includes game and non-game species (some of which are deer and bighorn sheep). This reserved right and other water rights for livestock (wild horses and burros) grazing common to the same Herd Management Area (HMA) will be limited to the quantity of water beneficially used within the HMA. This spring location was determined in the field with the Global Positioning System (GPS). Accuracy is ±3 feet
