448.83 gallons per minute equals 1 cubic foot per second.

(11) Remarks It is recognized that wildlife currently utilize this source and  
therefore sufficient water should be left at the source for this purpose and  
not be available for appropriation. Wildlife includes game and non-game  
species (some of which are deer, elk and antelope).

This reserved right and other water rights for livestock grazing common  
to the same grazing allotment shall be limited to the quantity of water  
beneficially used within the allotment.

The location of the source was determined in the field with Global  
Positioning System (GPS) units. Accuracy is within +/- 15 feet.
