(11) Remarks It is recognized that wildlife currently utilize this spring and therefore sufficient water should be left at the source for this purpose and not be available for appropriation. We have estimated that a minimum of 3 deer, 1 antelope, and 20 small game animals use this spring.

Protraction for T. 41 N., R. 49 E., was done by BLM Nevada State Office, July 1981 based on the 1873 and 1882 GLO plats. A brass cap survey (dependent and independent) was completed in 1981 and approved in 1984 in T. 41 N., R. 48 E., and there is some overlap between surveys. This overlap is depicted by the dashed line on the water rights map. Since Cadastral Survey does not know how this problem will be resolved until there is a new survey in T. 41 N., R. 49 E., we have used the best information available based on the 1873 and 1882 surveys. The legal description for this spring is likely to change when a new survey of T. 41 N., R. 49 E., is completed.
