(11) Remarks Phantom Spring flows for about 1000 feet and then dries up. It does not flow into Trout Creek.
It is recognized that wildlife currently utilize this spring and therefore sufficient water should be left at the
source for this purpose and not be available for appropriation. Wildlife include game and non-game species
(some of which are deer and antelope).

This reserved right and other water rights for livestock grazing common to the same grazing
allotment shall be limited to the quantity of water beneficially used within the allotment.


