(11) Remarks It is recognized that wildlife currently utilize this spring and therefore sufficient water should be left at the source for this purpose and not be available for appropriation. Wildlife include game and non-game species (some of which are deer and antelope). This reserved right and other water rights for livestock grazing common to the same grazing allotment shall be limited to the quantity of water beneficially used within the allotment. Amount claimed is based on the expected discharge once the spring is developed. The spring is not expected to supply enough water to meet demand from permitted use.
