

11) Remarks

This PWR is within the Granite Pasture of the Buffalo Hills Allotment. The source and place of use described above both fall within the bounds of the Granite Range Herd Management Area (HMA). The amount of water claimed is that volume which will ensure the perseverance of water for both human and animal consumption, wildlife habitat, and forage for wild and domesticated animals. 12780 GPD is needed for cattle use based on the stocking rate for this allotment (20 gal/head/day). Up to 10 GPD is needed for human consumption. Incidental use is expected up to 5160 GPD by wild horses based on AML for this HMA (20 gal/head/day) and 15520 GPD by wildlife based on reasonable numbers of mule deer, pronghorn antelope, and bighorn sheep (5 gal/animal/day).

The source and place of use both exist on lands owned by the United States which is managed by the BLM.
