This PWR is within the Granite Pasture of the Buffalo Hills Allotment. The amount of water claimed is that volume which will ensure the perseverance of water for both human and animal consumption, wildlife habitat, and forage for wild and domesticated animals. 12780 GPD is needed for cattle use based on the stocking rate for this allotment (20 gal/head/day). Up to 10 GPD is needed for human consumption. Incidental use of up to 15520 GPD is expected by wildlife based on reasonable numbers of mule deer, pronghorn antelope, and bighorn sheep (5 gal/animal/day).

The source and place of use both exist on lands owned by the United States which is managed by the BLM.
