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13) Remarks:

The amount of water claimed is that volume which will support healthy, vigorous riparian vegetation necessary to maintain the claimed surface flow for the identified purposes. This PWR is within newly delineated Sheep Springs Pasture (decision signed NOV 06, 2014), of the Flanigan Allotment. The entire quantity claimed under this PWR will be combined with other PWRs within this pasture to meet the total GPD needed. This is also an important source of water for human use including current and future uses such as hiking, horseback riding and camping. Use at this spring also serves wildlife species including mule deer, pronghorn antelope, bighorn and sage grouse; making it an important source of water for wildlife. Water quality is appropriate for purposes and types of uses claimed. The riparian area will serve to provide clean water for both human and animal consumption, wildlife habitat, and forage for wild and domesticated animals. The spring is developed under a Range Improvement Permit, Project Number 544325, with a spring box and pipeline to trough. A gate in the pipeline allows water to remain in riparian system when livestock are not grazing in the pasture. The source and place of use both fall within Core Greater Sage Grouse Habitat. The spring location and place of use are on lands owned by the United States.
