PROOF OF THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

1. Q. Postoffice.

A. *Yerington*

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.

A. *For Grain and Hay*

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.

4. Q. If through a ditch state its name.

A. *Ditch Recorded as A. Charlebois ditch*

5. Q. (a) State date of survey of the ditch or other distributing works through which the water claimed is diverted. (b) The date when the construction of such ditch was begun and when completed.

A. (a) *Survey for ditch was 1878*

(b) *Construction of ditch begun 10th day of Jan. and Completed Middle of Mar. 1878 on 80 acres in S.E. Cor. of Sect. 36.*

6. Q. If any enlargements were made state the date when begun and the date when completed.

A. *Extention Made into 120 acres in sect. 26 as shown on Map also 40 acres in the S.E. Cor. of SW/4 Sect. 26.*

7. Q. State dimensions of the ditch as originally constructed, and as enlarged.

A. *Ditch 18 inches deep, and 3 1/2 feet wide*

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. *A. Charlebois*

9. Q. State the nature of your title to the land for which an appropriation is claimed, and if not owned by you give the name of the owner and the nature of the possessory right which you exercise.

A. *A. Charlebois owns ground by State & US patent*

10. Q. State the year when water was first used for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, and by whom. A. *Water first used April 5-1879, 40 acres for grain, 10 acres for Vegetables, in S.E. Cor. of Sect. 36.*


