PROOF OF THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

State your name *J. W. Wilson*

1. Q. Postoffice.

A. *Yerington Lyon County Nevada*

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.

A. *raising Wheat Barley Hay Vegetables + Domestic Purposes also watering stock*

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.

A. *Dams and Ditches*

4. Q. If through a ditch state its name.

A. *Wilson Ditch*

5. Q. (a) State date of survey of the ditch or other distributing works through which the water claimed is diverted. (b) The date when the construction of such ditch was begun and when completed.

A. (a) *Surveyed in 1863*

(b) *Completed in Winter 1863 and 1864*

6. Q. If any enlargements were made state the date when begun and the date when completed.

A. *Never was enlarged*

7. Q. State dimensions of the ditch as originally constructed, and as enlarged.

A. *Originally Constructed (6 ft) six feet wide on bottom and (3 ft) three feet deep at headgate*

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. *Built by David Wilson and Wm Wilson Present owners David Wilson W Wilson J S Wilson Geo W Wilson and John Doe*

9. Q. State the nature of your title to the land for which an appropriation is claimed, and if not owned by you give the name of the owner and the nature of the possessory right which you exercise.

A. *Patent and Contract*

10. Q. State the year when water was first used for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, and by whom. If for irrigation, give the number of acres watered the first year, with the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

In the Year 1870 Irrigated NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec 27 About 10 Acres, In Year 1874 Irrigated the following the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 The SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec 27 About 40 Acres All above in T 12 N. R. 25 E

In Year 1877 Water used of the following land The SE 1/4 of NE 1/4, The NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 The NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, About 40 Acres. In year 1890 Irrigated the N 1/2 of SE 1/4 Sec 26 T 12, N. R. 25, E, About 45 Acres, Total Number of acres irrigated by said ditch being Two hundred and twenty five acres.

12. Q. If water is claimed for irrigation, give the legal subdivisions of land owned or controlled by you for which an appropriation is claimed.

A. Water is claimed for all the legal subdivisions above described also the following lands, The S 1/2 of SE 1/4 and the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec 26 T 12 N. R. 25 E, The E 1/2 of SW 1/4 Sec 22, The E 1/2 of NW 1/4, The SW 1/4 of NE 1/4, The NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 The S 1/2 of SE 1/4 Sec 27 T 12 N. R. 25-E, The NW 1/4 Sec 27 The E 1/2 of NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec 3 T 11 N. R. 25 E
