

## PROOF OF THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

State your name *H. C. Keema.*

1. Q. Postoffice.

A. *Yerington Lyon County Nevada*

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.

A. *Irrigation<sup>nd</sup> domestic purposes*

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.

A. *By Ditch*

4. Q. If through a ditch state its name.

A. *Greenwood Ditch*

5. Q. (a) State date of survey of the ditch or other distributing works through which the water claimed is diverted. (b) The date when the construction of such ditch was begun and when completed.

A. (a) *Began in 1864*

(b) *Completed year 1865*

6. Q. If any enlargements were made state the date when begun and the date when completed.

A. *No enlargements only by cleaning each year  
nd by the natural wash of the water.*

7. Q. State dimensions of the ditch as originally constructed, and as enlarged.

A. *Headgate 8ft wide; 6 feet high,*

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. *Built by W. B. Sanders, Gideon W. Cumbers  
nd Noah Greenwood.*

9. Q. State the nature of your title to the land for which an appropriation is claimed, and if not owned by you give the name of the owner and the nature of the possessory right which you exercise.

A. *By Deed.*

10. Q. State the year when water was first used for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, and by whom. If for irrigation, give the number of acres watered the first year, with the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. *1869. About 50 acres irrigated by John Chase,  
including all the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, and ten acres in the south  
end of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 3, T 12 N R 25 East. About  
30 <sup>additional</sup> acres put under cultivation<sup>nd</sup> irrigation during the year  
1872, being the West 1/2 of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Sect 3, T 12 N R 25 E  
- 20 Acres. nd ten acres in the east part of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
of said Section 3, T 12 N R 25 E. M. D. B. M.*

11. Q. State the number of acres watered each subsequent year, and give the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. About 20 acres irrigated 1873, being the 10 acres <sup>in the</sup> E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sect 3 - T. 12 N. R. 25 East and 10 acres in the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section 3.

12. Q. If water is claimed for irrigation, give the legal subdivisions of land owned or controlled by you for which an appropriation is claimed.

A. 30 Acres in the North half of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, T. 12 N. R. 25 E. and 20 acres in the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , same section and 10 <sup>acres</sup> near the center of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3, T. 12, N. R. 25, East Md. M.

13. Q. State the acreage said ditch is capable of watering, give the legal subdivisions of land which it can be made to irrigate, and state who owns said land.

A.

14. Q. State the character of the soil and the kind of crops cultivated.

A. Good agricultural land, Grain, hay, vegetables and fruits.

15. Q. Are you an owner in said ditch? If so state your proportionate interest therein.

A. Yes  $\frac{1}{4}$  interest of 96 Shares or 4 shares.

16. Q. The plat prepared by the State Engineer is hereby accepted as showing correctly the location of the Greenwood Ditch and the land which can be irrigated therefrom.

A. About correct.

17. Q. When does your irrigation season begin and when does it end?

A. About March 15<sup>th</sup> and ends about October 15 of each year.

18. Q. If water is used for other purposes than irrigation, state the nature of such use, the time when such use began, and how much water is required for such purpose.

A. Used for Stock, requiring small head <sup>the</sup> year around

19. Q. During what months is the water used?

A. All the year.

20. Q. Have you had sufficient water each year since the use for which an appropriation is claimed began? If not, state the years of scarcity, the months when the supply was insufficient, and the reason of such scarcity.

A. Have had sufficient water; with exceptions of a few years when water was short the latter part of the year due to a scarcity of snow and storm in the mountains, the winter previous.
