PROOF OF THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

1. Q. Postoffice.
A. Rebel Creek, Humboldt Co. Nevada

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.
A. Irrigation

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.
A. Sluiceways & ditches

4. Q. If through a ditch state its name.
A. Rebel Creek & Willow Creek ditches
Willow Creek ditch recorded as 2 mile & Shaw ditch

5. Q. (a) State date of survey of the ditch or other distributing works through which the water claimed is diverted. (b) The date when the construction of such ditch was begun and when completed.

A. (a) No record of survey
(b) Between 1874 and 1877.

6. Q. If any enlargements were made state the date when begun and the date when completed.
A. None.

7. Q. State dimensions of the ditch as originally constructed, and as enlarged.

A. 6 ft. wide 2 ft. deep 31950 ft. long Willow Creek.
Rebel Creek ditch 3 ft wide 2 ft. deep 5000 ft. long and also water taken out by small ditches on north side of Rebel Creek.

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. Willow Creek built by Wm. Shaw Present owner Humboldt Cattle Co.
Rebel Creek ditch built by Samuel Gusten, Jno. L. Snapp & August Scorell. Present owners Humboldt Cattle Co. & C.P. Snapp

A. See sample & contract to purchase from the State of Nevada.

A. Rebel Creek in 1866 by Samuel Gusten, Jno. L. Snapp and August Scorell. 480 acres S 1/2 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 5, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 6, E 1/2 NE 1/4 Sec. 7, NW 1/4 Sec. 8, & N 1/2 NE 1/4 Sec. 8 T. 43 N. R. 37 E.; Willow Creek ditch prior to 1877 by Wm. Shaw & Riley Hardaw. 1280 acres; in the following subdivisions: N 3/4 S 1/2 Sec. 6, W 3/4 N 1/2 Sec. 7, N 1/2 SW 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 43 N. R. 37 E.; SE 1/4, S 1/2 SW 1/4 Sec. 1, N 3/4 Sec. 12 T. 43 N. R. 36 E.

11. Q. State the number of acres watered each subsequent year, and give the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. During years prior to construction of Shaw & Willow Creek ditch the $W\frac{3}{4}$ & $S\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 5, $SE\frac{1}{4}$ & $SE\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 6, $E\frac{1}{2}$ $NE\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 7, $NW\frac{1}{4}$ & $NE\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8, were irrigated by the Rebel Creek ditch. Subsequent to construction of Shaw & Willow Creek ditches the following subdivisions ($W\frac{3}{4}$ & $S\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 5, $S\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 6, $N\frac{1}{2}$ and $NE\frac{1}{4}$ & $SW\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 7, $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and $NE\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8, T. 43 N. R. 37 E.; $SE\frac{1}{4}$ and $S\frac{1}{2}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 1 and $N\frac{3}{4}$ Sec. 12, T. 43 N. R. 36 E.) were irrigated by the joint ditches (Rebel Creek & Willow Creek & Shaw ditches). Shaw & Willow Creek ditch also irrigates all sec. 31, $W\frac{1}{2}$ $W\frac{1}{2}$, $SE\frac{1}{4}$ & $SW\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 32, T. 44 N. R. 37 E.; $E\frac{3}{4}$ $N\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. 6, $N\frac{1}{2}$ $S\frac{1}{2}$, $S\frac{1}{2}$ $N\frac{1}{2}$ & $S\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 5, T. 43 N. R. 37 E. (about 3080 acres)

12. Q. If water is claimed for irrigation, give the legal subdivisions of land owned or controlled by you for which an appropriation is claimed.

A. Same as above.

13. Q. State the acreage said ditch is capable of watering, give the legal subdivisions of land which it can be made to irrigate, and state who owns said land.

A. Claimant's interest capable watering 2920 acres of the above described lands owned by Humboldt & Cattle Co.

14. Q. State the character of the soil and the kind of crops cultivated.

A. Sagebrush and meadow lands of crop meadow hay

15. Q. Are you an owner in said ditch? If so state your proportionate interest therein.

A. Entire owner of Shaw ditch, all of Rebel Creek ditch, but cannot irrigate 180 acres owned by W. C. Snapp.
