(21) Remarks: The place was first settled on by (Cyrus?) Crowell about the year 1879. He was succeeded by George Crowell, his son, and Leander Ott. In 1890 Leander Ott bought out the Crowell interests. The subscriber was married to Leander Ott in 1891 and succeeded him in possession as his widow. Was married to Henry P. Millett in 1903. She applied for homestead in 1907 but was refused on the grounds that her husband, Henry P. Millett, was the head of the family. On this decision Henry P. Millett filed the application for homestead.

During severe winters there is quite a body of water flowing but it does not last long enough to be capable of turning to any use in regular irrigation. At the present time after a rain there is about seven miner's inches flowing and no more.


