PROOF OF THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

1. Q. Postoffice.

A. *Winnemucca, Humboldt County, Nevada*

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.

A. *Irrigation of lands, watering stock and domestic purposes.*

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.

A. *Dams and ditches*

4. Q. If through a ditch state its name.

A. *Through ditches taken out of McDermitt
Creek; that is to say a Southern tributary
or fork of McDermitt Creek*

5. Q. (a) State date of survey of the ditch or other distributing works through which the water claimed is diverted. (b) The date when the construction of such ditch was begun and when completed.

A. (a) *No surveyed ditch*(b) *Ditches were begun in April 1900 and have been
extended from time to time up to year 1906.*

6. Q. If any enlargements were made state the date when begun and the date when completed.

A. *No enlargements have been made*

7. Q. State dimensions of the ditch as originally constructed, and as enlarged.

A. *At head of ditch 2 feet deep by 3 feet wide at
bottom.*

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. *Built by present owner, Harry
Alley.*

9. Q. State the nature of your title to the land for which an appropriation is claimed, and if not owned by you give the name of the owner and the nature of the possessory right which you exercise.

A. *My present title is that of entry under
Rept. Land Laws of the United States. Final proof
of which has been made and submitted*

10. Q. State the year when water was first used for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, and by whom. If for irrigation, give the number of acres watered the first year, with the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. *In year 1900 by P. Boyd. Lands
are unsurveyed. In the neighborhood
of twenty five acres irrigated the first
year.*

11. Q. State the number of acres watered each subsequent year, and give the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. 1901 about 40^{acres}; in 1902 about 80 acres; in 1903 about 100 acres; in 1904 about 100 acres; in 1905 about 100 acres; in 1906 about 100 acres; in 1907 about 140 acres; in 1908 about 200 acres and in 1909 about 200 acres.

The lands embraced in my entry are unsurveyed. Application for survey has been made

12. Q. If water is claimed for irrigation, give the legal subdivisions of land owned or controlled by you for which an appropriation is claimed.

A. Water is claimed for irrigation on the lands described as follows, to wit:—
"A strip of land $\frac{1}{2}$ mile in width by one mile in length situated on McDermitt Creek about 3 miles from the head of said creek and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile southerly from the boundary line between the States of Oregon and Nevada, which lands are unsurveyed, and are also situated about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the original survey of lands surveyed in Oregon, lying East of the tract applied for."

13. Q. State the acreage said ditch is capable of watering, give the legal subdivisions of land which it can be made to irrigate, and state who owns said land.

A. Ditch is capable of watering all of said lands with exception of extreme Northern and Southern portions, which are high rocky points, inaccessible, consisting of about 100 acres not capable of irrigation

14. Q. State the character of the soil and the kind of crops cultivated.

A. Soil is Sandy Loam. Crops cultivated are Timothy and Redtop, and wild hay.

15. Q. Are you an owner in said ditch? If so state your proportionate interest therein.

A. I am full, sole owner of said ditch.

16. Q. The plat prepared by the State Engineer is hereby accepted as showing correctly the location of the _____ Ditch and the land which can be irrigated therefrom.

A. _____

17. Q. When does your irrigation season begin and when does it end?

A. Begins about April 15th and ends about July 1st of each year.
