The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation:

(21) Remarks: The Nevada Wonder Mining Co. purchased the Horse Creek Ranch together with water rights and other rights appertaining thereto from J. A. Kirby et al. who deeded and quit-claimed the property to J. B. Daniel, Trustee; and J. B. Daniel as Trustee afterward deeded the property to the Nevada Wonder Mining Company who now own it. During the year 1911 the ranch was leased by the Nevada Wonder Mining Company to a tenant, who grew and sold several wagon loads of potatoes, and other vegetables from the ranch, and used the alfalfa as grazing ground, for horses. Necessarily, on account of lack of records, much of the information embodied in this application regarding former years has had to be obtained by questioning old inhabitants and from various other sources.
