

# THE STATE OF NEVADA.

## PROOF OF THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

In the matter of Springs on Dun Glen & Alda Lang Canyon reference to No 1097  
State your name J. H. Hendra

1. Q. Postoffice.

A. Chaparral Nevada

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.

A. Irrigating - Stock watering & domestic purposes

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.

A. Ditch and pipe line

4. Q. If through a ditch state its name.

A. Dun Glen ditch

5. Q. (a) State date of survey of the ditch or other distributing works through which the water claimed is diverted. (b) The date when the construction of such ditch was begun and when completed.

A. (a) when appropriation No Survey was made

(b) begun 1868 Completed 1869

6. Q. If any enlargements were made state the date when begun and the date when completed.

A. No enlargements were cleaning out

7. Q. State dimensions of the ditch as originally constructed, and as enlarged.

A. from 2 to 3 feet wide at top and 2 feet deep

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. Charles Gegg and Charles Osborne

Present owners J H Hendra my brother J H Hendra was partner with me he was killed in 1908 Dec 28<sup>th</sup>

9. Q. State the nature of your title to the land for which an appropriation is claimed, and if not owned by you give the name of the owner and the nature of the possessory right which you exercise.

A. Possessory or squatters right and have been in possession of it for 20 years past and bought all the other rights of other parties who held possession for 20 years prior thereto.

10. Q. State the year when water was first used for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, and by whom. If for irrigation, give the number of acres watered the first year, with the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. I was informed by the parties from whom my brother and I purchased that they commenced using the water in 1868, and it has been continuously used ever since by them and myself I do not know the number of acres they irrigated my brother and myself irrigated from 50 to 75 acres when there was sufficient water. <sup>the</sup> for last 20 years

11. Q. State the number of acres watered each subsequent year, and give the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. from 5 to 20 acres a few acres in No 11 and a few acres in No 10 also a few acres in 15 and 16 in township No 23 Pa of Range No 34, E. 1<sup>st</sup> M.D. In the Canyon runs diagonally across these sections and it is only little patches here and there that can be irrigated and cultivated and these have been irrigated and cultivated since the construction of the ditch and have been irrigated & cultivated by me and my brother for the past 20 years continuously and also used for domestic purposes and watering stock a survey plan of said ditch was filed in State Engineers Office about July or August 1908 by Crocker or Westcott & Co.

12. Q. If water is claimed for irrigation, give the legal subdivisions of land owned or controlled by you for which an appropriation is claimed.

A. Yes stock watering and domestic purposes and the land irrigated & cultivated by me and my Brothers family is as above described as near as I know how

13. Q. State the acreage said ditch is capable of watering, give the legal subdivisions of land which it can be made to irrigate, and state who owns said land.

A. the ditch has capacity of carrying sufficient water to irrigate from 50 to 75 acres but there never have been sufficient water after the Spring flush to fill the ditch and after June 1<sup>st</sup> there has not been sufficient water to irrigate more than 5 acres in any year since I have been here

14. Q. State the character of the soil and the kind of crops cultivated.

A. Rich sandy soil alfalfa and garden truck

15. Q. Are you an owner in said ditch? If so state your proportionate interest therein.

A. I own all since my brother death

16. Q. The plat prepared by the State Engineer is hereby accepted as showing correctly the location of the \_\_\_\_\_ Ditch and the land which can be irrigated therefrom.

A. I do not know what the State Engineer plat shows if there is one

17. Q. When does your irrigation season begin and when does it end?

A. Generally in March ends in September

18. Q. If water is used for other purposes than irrigation, state the nature of such use, the time when such use began, and how much water is required for such purpose.

A. Watering stock and domestic purposes during the whole year

19. Q. During what months is the water used?

A. During the whole year

20. Q. Have you had sufficient water each year since the use for which an appropriation is claimed began? If not, state the years of scarcity, the months when the supply was insufficient, and the reason of such scarcity.

A. No - every year that I have been sure that is since we purchased the property or right to the water and ditch
