1. Q. Postoffice.

A. Ely, Nevada.

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.

A. Watering of live stock & domestic purposes

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.

A. Water troughs, and small dams across lower part of creek

4. Q. If through a ditch state its name.

A. Coubs Creek, water troughs.

5. Q. (a) State date of survey of the ditch or other distributing works through which the water claimed is diverted. (b) The date when the construction of such ditch was begun and when completed.

(b) Water troughs & small dams were constructed during the year 1900

6. Q. If any enlargements were made state the date when begun and the date when completed.

A. Water troughs were built and put in place during the year 1900

7. Q. State dimensions of the ditch as originally constructed, and as enlarged.

A. 12 x 12 x 100 feet long

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. Water troughs were constructed and put in place and are now owned by Adams & McGee

9. Q. State the nature of your title to the land for which an appropriation is claimed, and if not owned by you give the name of the owner and the nature of the possessory right which you exercise.

A. The premises are held and used by possessory title being located upon unsurveyed land, by Adams & McGee

10. Q. State the year when water was first used for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, and by whom. If for irrigation, give the number of acres watered the first year, with the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. This water was first used by William or Bertha in the year 1873, for watering stock.

11. Q. State the number of acres watered each subsequent year, and give the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. This stream is not large enough to be used for irrigation purposes, and is used only for watering stock. At present the mouth of the stream is small and sheep can not water only that trough on bank and water can trough them otherwise the sheep would drink the stream to such an extent that they will not drink the water.

12. Q. If water is claimed for irrigation, give the legal subdivisions of land owned or controlled by you for which an appropriation is claimed.

A. Water is being used for live stock and domestic purposes.

19. Q. During what months is the water used?

A. From March to December for watering sheep and during the latter years for cattle feed.

20. Q. Have you had sufficient water each year since the use for which an appropriation is claimed began? If not, state the years of scarcity, the months when the supply was insufficient, and the reason of such scarcity.

A. Yes by using water troughs. During the early part of the year the stream would permit of watering without trough but after the month of June it is so small that water troughs must be used.

Remarks: Coult's Creek is situated about three miles north of "Archie's" Springs, on the road leading from Wood to Archa's mining District, and is on the Butte valley water shed.

These Springs were originally owned and used by Williamson Brothers for watering live stock in the year 1873. This owning to some under possessory right, which title has been regularly handed down through various owners to Adam & M. Gill who now claim and own the same through their possessory rights and continuous use.

The improvement consist of water troughs, Durrall Cabin, small dams below the troughs which catch any overflow from boxes and permit stock watering from same. These Springs were also cleaned and water developed by Adam & M. Gill, and are kept continually cleaned, that the flow of water may not depreciate more than possible.

Like most mountain streams the supply of water decreases in the middle of the year so that it is impossible to water a large band of sheep with out the aid of the water troughs. Improvements and cleaning spring, repairing water trough, and making dam on avenue beyond.
