Edward Wolfe, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Nevada & California Land & Live Stock Co. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Deponent makes this proof on behalf of claimant and by virtue of his office of Secretary of said Company

(1) Name of claimant Nevada & California Land and Live Stock Company  
Address Reno, County of Humboldt  
State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is 2 + 1 inch pipes each 50 ft. long  
(3) The water is impounded in 3 wooden tanks or troughs

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun and completed prior to January 1, 1899

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory

(6) The claimant's water right <sup>(Certificate of Appropriation)</sup> was ~~was not~~ recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Humboldt County, at page 13 of Book A of Water Certificates

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 2500 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 20 days during each of the following months, December, January, February and March

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 2500 in 1907 and succeeding years, except in those occasional years when there is an abundance of snow on the ground. During all years since 1907 from 15 to 20 head of horses have been watered at said spring by claimants daily during the months of December to March, both inclusive

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been.....

0.013 cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at ~~Said Spring~~ <sup>in N<sup>w</sup> of NW<sup>4</sup></sup> S.E. about 1500 feet  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
from the N.W. corner of Section 7, T. 25 N., R. 25  
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at at and within 100 feet from said spring  
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: This amended proof of appropriation is made and filed for the purpose of correcting and more accurately describing the position of said spring as stated in the original proof of appropriation filed Dec 8, 1910. At the time the original proof was made, said sp. 25 N. R 25 E. was unsurveyed and the position of said spring was inaccurately stated.

The right to the use of the water is claimed for domestic and stock watering purposes.

The spring mentioned in this amended proof of appropriation is the same spring for the use of the waters of which Certificate of appropriation int<sup>o</sup>. 0814 was issued by the State Engineer, August 20, 1912.

the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Nevada & California Land & Live Stock Co. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Proof is made by affiant as Secretary of Claimant and under authority of its Board of Directors

(1) Name of claimant Nevada & California Land & Live Stock Company Address Reno County of Washoe State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is through 2 iron pipes each 1 inch in dia & 5 feet long Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 3 wooden tanks Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun and completed prior to Jan. 1, 1899

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory right by occupancy, the land being Government land and unsurveyed

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of days during each of the following months

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant and its predecessors in interest in subsequent years was as follows: about 20,000 head of sheep and about 500 head of horses and cattle

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been 6 gallons per minute. .01335 cc-ft.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second cubic feet per second.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at 6 1/2 miles north and 1 3/8 miles East True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance foot  
from the Common corner of Section ---, T. 24 + 25 N., R. 24 + 25,  
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
