

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Stone House Springs Name of natural water source.

Through Edward Halfe Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Nevada California Land & Live Stock Co. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Proof is made by affiant as Secretary of Claimant and under authority of its Board of Directors

(1) Name of claimant Nevada California Land & Live Stock Co. Address Reno, County of Washoe State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is three iron pipes 12 inches in diameter, 50 feet long each

(3) The water is impounded in 8 wooden tanks

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun and completed in 1899 and completed.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory right, the land being unencumbered Government land

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of days during each of the following months

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant and its predecessors in interest in subsequent years was as follows: about 20,000 head of sheep and about 500 head of cattle and horses

- (9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been 11 gallons per minute ^{1024 Sec. ft.} ~~cubic feet per second.~~
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second
- (10) The water is diverted from its source at 19 miles west and 1 5/8 miles south ^{True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance} ~~foot~~
 from the common corner of Section , T27 & 28 N, R. 27 & 28 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

- (11) The works are located at or near said springs
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The position of the springs above described is based on an actual survey completed November 27, 1910.

For a more particular description of the developments and improvements made at said springs, reference is hereby made to the original proof of appropriation filed in the above matter in the office of the State Engineer, December 8, 1910.

Said springs are commonly and will be known as Stone House Springs

A. Land unsurveyed Government domain; possessory rights by occupancy, company owning and maintaining thereon House and barn for men and horses and corralls for handling of stock.

If for irrigation, give the number of acres watered the first year, with the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. Use of the water is continuous throughout entire year.

20. Q. Have you had sufficient water each year since the use for which an appropriation is claimed began? If not, state the years of scarcity, the months when the supply was insufficient, and the reason of such scarcity.

A. Water has been sufficient only for the purposes used, but no surplus.
