PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Tunnel Springs Name of natural water source.

Through Edward Wolfe Name of ditch, pipe line, etc. the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Nevada California Land & Live Stock Co are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Proof is made by affiant as Secretary of Claimant and under authority of its Board of Directors

(1) Name of claimant Nevada California Land & Live Stock Co. Address Reno, County of Humboldt, State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is iron pipe 1 inch in diameter 100 feet long. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 4 wooden tanks. Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun and completed prior to January 1, 1899

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory right based on occupation, the land being Government land and unsurveyed

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of days during each of the following months

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: about 20,000 head of sheep and about 500 head of horses and cattle

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been 4 gallons per minute .008 cfs cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at 15 3/8 miles west and 7/8 mile South feet from the Common corner of Section _____, T. 27+28 N, R. 27+28 E, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

Note--Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at said spring
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The position of the springs above given is based on an actual survey completed November 27th 1910

Reference is hereby made to the original proof of appropriation and plat filed in the above matter in the office of the State Engineer, December 8, 1910, for a more particular description of the developments and improvements made at said springs. Said springs are commonly and well known as Summit Springs.

PROOF OF THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

State your name Nevada and California Land and Live Stock Company, a corporation.

1. Q. Postoffice.

A. Post Office Box 163, Reno, Nevada.

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.

A. Domestic uses and watering live stock

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.

A. Development of said waters was accomplished by driving a tunnel 4 ft. wide and six feet high, 100 feet long, through earth and stone.

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. Original constructors and owners Geo. Frazier and Scott Lee. Present owner Nevada and California Land and Live Stock Company.

9. Q. State the nature of your title to the land for which an appropriation is claimed, and if not owned by you give the name of the owner and the nature of the possessory right which you exercise.

A. Land unsurveyed Government domain. Possessory rights by occupancy. Company maintaining watering tanks for storage of water and pipe conveying same to tanks.

10. Q. State the year when water was first used for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, and by whom. If for irrigation, give the number of acres watered the first year, with the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. Waters were first used for beneficial purposes prior to January 1, 1899 by Geo. Frazier and Scott Lee, and the present claimant and its grantors have been in the possession thereof since said date.

11. Q. State the number of acres watered each subsequent year, and give the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

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Water developed by driving a tunnel and conserved by conveying same to 4 wooden tanks by means of an iron pipe one inch in diameter, 100 feet in length. Quantity of water developed 4 gallons per minute.


