First used in 1863, about two acres in the N/E 1/4 of the N/W 1/4 of Sec. 24, by George W. Ruer. Water from Navier in said 1/4 sec.

11. Q. State the number of acres watered each subsequent year, and give the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

In 1864 about 40 acres added in the W 1/2 of the N/W 1/4 of Sec 24. In 1865 about 25 acres added in same legal subdivision. In 1889 about 35 acres added in E 1/2 of the N/W 1/4 of Sec 24. In 1872 about 30 acres added in the E 1/2 of the S/W 1/4 of Sec 24. In 1873 about 30 acres added in same legal subdivision. Water from Cochrane Ditch. In 1878 about 90 acres added in the S/W 1/4 of Sec 24. Water from the same ditch. Water now being used from Outside Irrigating Canal.

All in T 19 N R 19 E.

In 1877, 25 acres added in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec 13 T 19 N R 19 E - water from Cochrane Ditch.
