AMENDED PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION

From A Spring (Barus Spring) Name of natural water source

O. W. PARUS, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by O. W. PARUS Claimant are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant O. W. Parus Address White Rock, County of Elko State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed Dam about 300 ft. below spring diverts water into ditch. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was in the year 1876

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1876 and completed 1876

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 2 ft. a natural grade with lay of land feet, width on top 3 ft. feet, depth 18" feet, on a grade of 6/ feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged. NOTE—If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun No enlargement except cleaning out and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom 2 ft. feet, width on top 3 ft. feet, depth 18" feet, on a grade of a natural grade with lay of land feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit.

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is State Contract land

(11) Crops of grain and vegetables have been grown upon the land irrigated.

1. Q. Postoffice.

A. Whiterock, Nevada, (Elko County)

2. Q. State the use to which the water has been applied.

A. Irrigation.

3. Q. State the means of diversion employed.

A. Ditch.

4. Q. If through a ditch state its name.

A. Storff Ditch.

5. Q. (a) State date of survey of the ditch or other distributing works through which the water claimed is diverted. (b) The date when the construction of such ditch was begun and when completed.

A. (a) Survey for ditch was made in the year 1875.

(b) In the year 1876.

6. Q. If any enlargements were made state the date when begun and the date when completed.

A. No enlargements made except the cleaning of the ditch from time to time.

7. Q. State dimensions of the ditch as originally constructed, and as enlarged.

A. The ditch was originally about eighteen inches ^{on the bottom} and has not ~~enlarged~~ been enlarged except by the washing of the water.

8. Q. State the name of person, association of persons or corporation who built the ditch or canal, and the name or names of its present owners.

A. Ditch was built by Antone Storff, and is now owned by
O. W. PARUS.

9. Q. State the nature of your title to the land for which an appropriation is claimed, and if not owned by you give the name of the owner and the nature of the possessory right which you exercise.

A. Contract or State Land.

10. Q. State the year when water was first used for irrigation or other beneficial purposes, and by whom. If for irrigation, give the number of acres watered the first year, with the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. Water was first used in the year 1876, by Antone Storff, and the ~~amount of water used~~ number of acres irrigated the first year was twelve or fourteen acres, all in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, Tp. 44, N. of R. 52 E. M. D. M.

11. Q. State the number of acres watered each subsequent year, and give the legal subdivisions on which the water was used, and as near as may be the acres irrigated in each legal subdivision.

A. From one to ten acres, all in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8. Tp. 44, N. of R. 52 E. M.D.M.

12. Q. If water is claimed for irrigation, give the legal subdivisions of land owned or controlled by you for which an appropriation is claimed.

A. ~~Two~~ About ten or twelve acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, Tp. 44 N. of R. 52 E. M.D.M.

13. Q. State the acreage said ditch is capable of watering, give the legal subdivisions of land which it can be made to irrigate, and state who owns said land.

A. From ten to twelve acres. Land owned by O. W. Parus

14. Q. State the character of the soil and the kind of crops cultivated.

A. A rich black loam; potatoes, grain, grass, and all kinds of vegetables.

15. Q. Are you an owner in said ditch? If so state your proportionate interest therein.

A. I own the entire ditch.

16. Q. The plat prepared by the State Engineer is hereby accepted as showing correctly the location of the Storff Ditch and the land which can be irrigated therefrom.

A.

17. Q. When does your irrigation season begin and when does it end?

A. Begins about May 1st and ends about August, 15th.

18. Q. If water is used for other purposes than irrigation, state the nature of such use, the time when such use began, and how much water is required for such purpose.

A. Water used for irrigation purposes only.

19. Q. During what months is the water used?

A. May, June, July, and Part of August.

20. Q. Have you had sufficient water each year since the use for which an appropriation is claimed began? If not, state the years of scarcity, the months when the supply was insufficient, and the reason of such scarcity.

A. There has always been sufficient water except the last few years when the water has been taken from my ditch by John S. Winter. (This water that I claim comes from a spring on my land, the forty acres just East of the land irrigator.)
