Remarks: After extending the Parker Ditch in 1875 all of the above listed land was irrigated within the following year or year and a half, and I claim a priority of 1875 for all of it.

(15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was six hundred forty-two & 1/10 acres.

(16) The water claimed has ~~been~~ been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated.

(17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were 1906 and 1907 water was used for a portion of the year only owing to flood and changes in ditches.

(18) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of _____ County, said record being at page _____ of Book _____ of _____, and being a claim for _____ of water for the irrigation of _____ acres of land in the following legal subdivisions:

NOTE—Failure to record in the county in no way invalidates a water right, but if ditch or right was so recorded, supply full information under (10).

19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: watering stock.

21) Remarks: The right covered in this proof was initiated in 1862 by Barrett, Dillard, and D.M. Whiteman through the Barrett and Reinwald ditch which was originally (as constructed in 1862) 5 ft. wide at top, 3 ft. at bottom, 2 ft. deep, grade unknown; enlarged 1863 to 8 ft. on top, 3 ft. deep, 5 ft. on bottom, grade unknown. In 1867 the Parker ditch was taken out, 18 ft. on top, 12 ft. on bottom and 5 ft. deep, and water was thereafter taken through both the Barrett and Reinwald ditch for the irrigation of the lands formerly irrigated by the latter named ditch. Additions to the irrigated acreage were made from time to time as indicated under (14). The first increase over the original acreage irrigated was in 1875 when I extended the Parker ditch to cover the land in Secs. 26 and 35, and continued cultivating land as rapidly as possible until all the land now irrigated in these sections was under irrigation.
