Remarks: After the New River Ditch was completed the water was at once applied to all the lands which I now irrigate east of the West line of Secs. 24, 25, and 36, T. 18 N. R. 29 E/ and West of the Slough in Secs. 25 and 36. After building the flume extension of the ditch in 1891-all the lands east of the slough now irrigated were put under water

(15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was 764.1 acres.

(16) The water claimed has ~~been~~ <sup>Strike out one not wanted.</sup> been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated.

(17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were No year.

19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stock & Domestic.

21) Remarks: The New River Ditch was first constructed in April 1873, and was reconstructed in 1874, the headgate being moved down the river about 2 miles to prevent the ditch filling with sand. The headgate is now located on the E. side of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 13, T. 18 N. R. 29 E., and is 3 ft. deep and 4 ft. wide.

In 1891 completed the construction of a ditch and flume from a reservoir in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24, used to impound water from the New River through the New Ditch to cover the lands listed herein with a priority of 1891. all of these lands having been irrigated in 1891 immediately after the construction of the ditch.


