

(22) Remarks: This amended proof of appropriation is submitted for filing for the reason that an error was made in describing the irrigated land in the original proof of appropriation. The map filed Jan. 19, 1912 in the State Engineer's Office shows the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 36, T. 31 N., R. 45 E., as being in Sage Brush, but as a matter of fact this area was put under cultivation during years prior to 1905 whenever the water supply of Rock Creek warranted the planting of crops. At present the entire NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 36, T. 31 N., R. 45 E., is fully planted in alfalfa.

During years of water shortage the waste water from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 31 N., R. 45 E., was allowed to flow onto the land in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 36, T. 31 N., R. 45 E., and create pasture.
