

Remarks: ~~This amended proof of appropriation of water from Bird Spring by Willard H. George for stock watering and domestic purposes is being filed to supersede original proof of appropriation No. 01037, for water from Bird Spring by Wilson Brothers, whose water rights have since been transferred to Willard H. George.~~  
The reason for this amended proof of appropriation is that the original location of point of diversion and place of use of water was in error. At the time the original survey was made, about May, 1911, a line was run from a section corner several miles north of the actual location of the spring, and a rock mound which came on line and about the proper distance was used as a quarter corner in the original survey. Recent investigation failed to develop anything that would indicate this rock mound as being an original one quarter corner, and the corner as shown on the map accompanying this amended proof of appropriation was found and is without question the original government corner. Since the new location does not check the old location and the corner used in the old location is questionable, this amended proof of appropriation and new map is being submitted to correct all existing records.
