PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Head waters of Pole Creek
Name of natural water source.

Through Dipping tank Flume
Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

James P. O'Neil, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by O'Neil Brothers are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Deponent represents claimant by virtue of being one of the partners
If proof is made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant O'Neil Brothers.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam, Ditch and Flume.
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Troughs and Tanks.
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun May, 1891
and completed in June, 1891.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is
Alabama Scrip.

(6) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of
County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 10,000
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of all of the days during each
of the following months April, May, June, July and August.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:
From ten thousand to thirty five thousand, per year.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been.....
about one (1) cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 0° 15' E. 2600 feet
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
from the North Quarter corner of Section 15 T. 46 N R. 61 E
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at S.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 Sec. 15
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The water from this spring is principally used during
the months of June and September for watering and dipping sheep.
For the other months it is used for watering stock.
