(2) The means of diversion employed is dam and reservoir
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in reservoir
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in year 1887
and completed in year 1887

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is reentered government land

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of _____ County, at page _____ of Book _____ of _____

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 800
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 360 days during each of the following months each month of the year

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:
a band of cattle ranging from 500 to 800 head

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been One
half of one miner's inch ^{cubic feet per second.}

(10) The water is ^{impounded} ~~diverted~~ from its source at N. 83° 30' West about 900 feet
from the E. quarter corner of Section 2, T. 228, R. 58,
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at N 83° 30' West about 900 ft from E. quarter, Cor of Sec 2, T. 228
R. 58 E. 1/4 30m. Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

by claimants as James B. Wilson and son
about the year 1887 and since the death of
James B. Wilson, by claimants have used
the water from this spring for their cattle
operating as Wilson Bros. This spring was
 dug out and cleaned out and reservoir made
at ^{about 60 ft below} springs by establishing dam across center
of stream and backing up the water, making a
reservoir at the source ^{such distance from}. This spring has been
cleaned out and dam and reservoir renewed from
time to time during each year since 1887. The
waters from this spring are and have been
since 1887 constantly used by the cattle of claimants
since 1887
