Remarks: ^{Blanco Canyon} The water in tunnel was first developed by the Well Annie Mining & Milling Co. of Salt Lake City Utah but was abandoned by them 1904 and I have used the water before and after the company abandoned said property. The development work done by aforesaid company consists of about 1000 ft of tunnel and spring of which I mention was used for domestic purpose & stock purpose is situated about 700 feet Northwesterly from tunnel where the water comes out.
