

(21) Remarks: There are 63 of these small springs situated on the land in question; small ditches are used to convey the water from the springs and cause the water to flood over the land, producing crops of hay; the water is not used for any other purpose than irrigating hay land and then after the hay is cut, it is used to create pasture land for my stock. I cut about 300 ~~tons~~ ^{3 hay} tons each year off this land, worth about \$15 a ton.
