his predecessors are full and correct to the best of his
knowledge and belief.

(21) Remarks: No other person except grantor and his predecessors have made use of this water since first appropriation about 1885. The water was conveyed by the "Old Ditch" mentioned for many years - until May - 1911, in fact. At that time I concluded to construct a new ditch, making a shorter distance to convey the water - The old ditch did not carry all the water of the stream; part was conveyed onto the land through the original channel. I accordingly constructed the present ditch large enough to carry all the water of the stream.
