PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION

From Franklin River Name of natural water source

Through No name to ditches--water taken direct from natural stream. Name of ditch, flume, or pipe line

Thomas V. Odgers, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by

Thomas V. Odgers are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Thomas V. Odgers (White Pine County) Address Butte Valley (Cherry Creek P.O.) County of Elko State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed Dams. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was January 9th., 1913.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun no construction of main water way-- and completed cross ditches probably constructed in 1875 and later.

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed is natural water way: Width on bottom 10 feet feet, width on top 12 feet feet, depth 2 1/2 feet, on a grade of One foot per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged. Note--If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is the owner in the above-described land water within his land.

If claimant is an owner in the conduit, state interest held on this line

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is Warranty Deed. Quit claims

(11) Crops of Wild grass have been grown upon the land irrigated.


(12) The water has been used for irrigation from March 15th to July 1st of each year, at which time the flow generally ceases.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or first grantors in the year 1875 when 75.17 acres were irrigated in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Lot 1 of Sec. 19 T. 30N, R. 60E, E., M.D.M. as far as known by deponent.

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Domestic use during cutting of the grass, also watering of horses (12) ~~acres~~ acres.

(21) Remarks: Watering of horses during the flow of the water and during the time of cutting the hay on the ranch---after July 1st water for horses and for domestic use, is done by means of a well on the ranch.

Proof 01264 executed by Thomas V. Odgers as Claimant is hereby amended as follows:




