The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 1, T. 11 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M.; also the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T. 11 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M., known as the "Barker Ranch," consisting of 120 acres; and also conveying to said R.M.P. & W. Co. all water and water rights in Shipley Canyon, the right to the use of said waters being appurtenant to said above described lands; also all buildings, fixtures and improvements appurtenant to the above described premises described in that certain deed of conveyance executed by the Tonopah Exploration Company to F. W. Dixon and J. F. Stebbins, dated Nov. 10, 1908, recorded Jan. 9, 1909, in Book 22 of Deeds, Page 59, Records of Nye County, it being the true intent and purpose of this instrument to convey to said R.M.P. & W. Co. all and singular the right, title, claim, estate and interest of said Dixon and Stebbins of, in and to the above described premises, and all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging, and specially and particularly including ~~any~~ and all waters and water rights appertaining thereto whether specifically described therein or not.
