The supporting Certificate 01473 indicates that 2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.5S., R.69E. had been eliminated from use. This was possibly so for a short period after the railroad was relocated. Shortly thereafter, however this field was put back into use with meadow pasture. The new map supporting this filing indicates 4.6 acres in this field.


